**Year 5:** Make a poster about the rules in your local community.

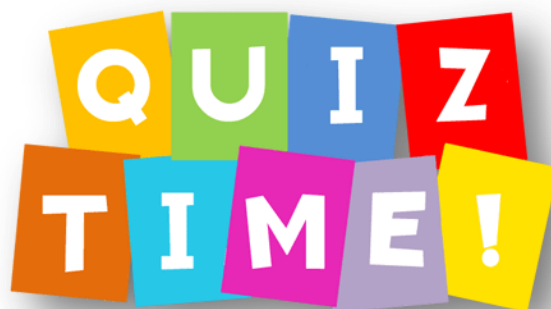
**Year 6:** Relax and get an early night on Sunday!
