Outstanding Key Stage 2 Results!


We are thrilled to announce that Ark Conway's KS2 SATs results are significantly higher than the national averages! The table below shows just how well our Year 6 children have done:

Subject	Pupils achieving the expected standard: nationally (2018)	Pupils achieving the expected standard at Ark Conway (2018)
Reading	75%	93%
Writing	78%	97%
Mathematics	76%	97%
Reading, Writing, Mathematics combined	64%	93%

Additionally, in mathematics 43% of children reached 'Greater Depth'; in writing 47% of children attained this and in reading a phenomenal 57% of our children reached 'Greater Depth'. Well done!
