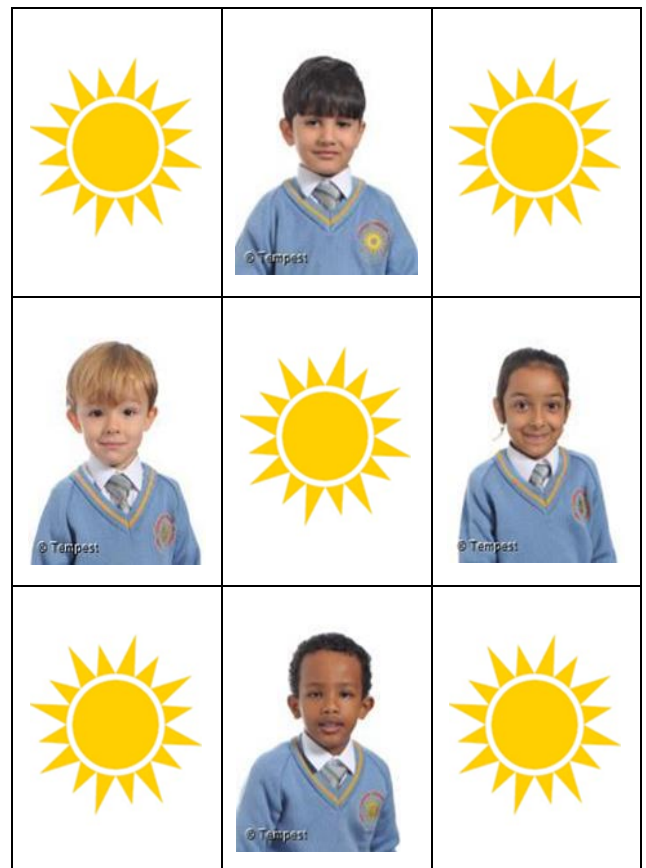

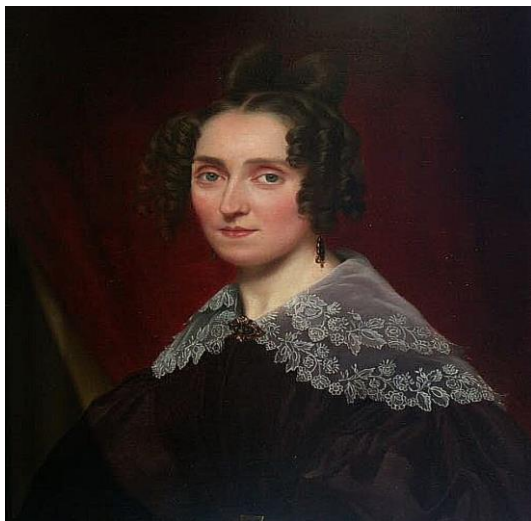

Reception: This week, we have been learning about planets and space in Farah Class. When it gets dark, look into the sky and see if you can spot any stars. Take a photo or draw a picture to share what you find.
