
Parents Forum - Finance Overview

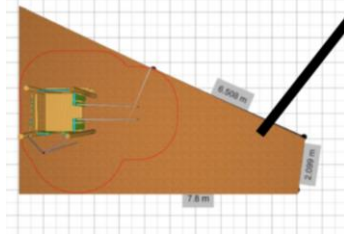
Library Fundraising
