**Reception:** This week, we have been learning the story of The Little Red Hen. Practice reading the story at home using the story map. Can you remember the different voices for each of the animals?

**Year 1:** We have been learning about adjectives this week! Choose one of your favourite toys and describe it with as many adjectives as you can. you could write these down or say them. Present your work however you like.

**Year 2:** This week we visited the Science Museum on our trip. What was your favourite part about the visit and what did you learn? Present your work in any way you like!

**Year 3:** This week we have been thinking about how we can use the multiplication and division skills we have learned this term in real life.
