We'd also like to remind all pupils of our **CHALLENGE**:




To design a poster of 'The Learning Pit' and bring it into your class teacher by Monday 17th January.

Reception: Make a den at home with your child and have a tea party inside. This could be as simple as a sheet across two chairs with a jug and two cups underneath. Please share your photos on Seesaw, we'd love to see them!

Year 1: Madison wants to know how inventions develop over time. Can you create a development timeline for a vehicle?

Year 2: Choose one of the seven continents and draw the outline of it. Research some facts about the continent to write inside the shape.

Year 3: Research a physical feature in Europe. Present your findings in any way you would like.

Year 4: Can you research any South American artists? What artwork of theirs is your favourite? What inspired their art?

Year 5: What are magnets and how do they impact us in our everyday lives?

Year 6: In English, we are writing stories that build suspense! Have a think about what the school would look like at midnight. You can present your findings however you wish, it doesn't have to be writing! You might choose to draw a picture or even create a model! What's important is that you have ideas ready!
