Reception: How have you changed since the beginning of Reception? Think about your physical changes as well as what you have learnt!

Year 1: Based on your knowledge of human and physical features in geography, what would the world be like if we had NO physical features and ONLY had human features. Get creative with how you present your ideas.

Year 2: This week in science we looked at sunflower seeds and seedlings. Can you find an

example of a different plant near your house? Draw and label it with any information you know or can find out.

Year 3: This week in science, we have been learning about forces. Can you find some examples at home of when you use a push or pull force? Take pictures of these or present them in another way!

Year 4: Can you make a travel brochure about a chosen USA state? What are the main landmarks, both physical and man-made? What is the key information about that state?

Year 5: What can you find out about the stages of child development? Create a chart or poster to show how children change in their first four years. You can include drawings, clipart or even real photographs from your family to illustrate your research.

Year 6: Read through your new production script. Practice your audition extract and song ready to perform on Tuesday.
