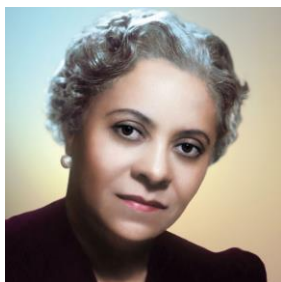
Finally, as you all know, we are choosing new names for each of our classes and we need your help! Please create a presentation to share with your class next week about someone who you believe is inspiring.

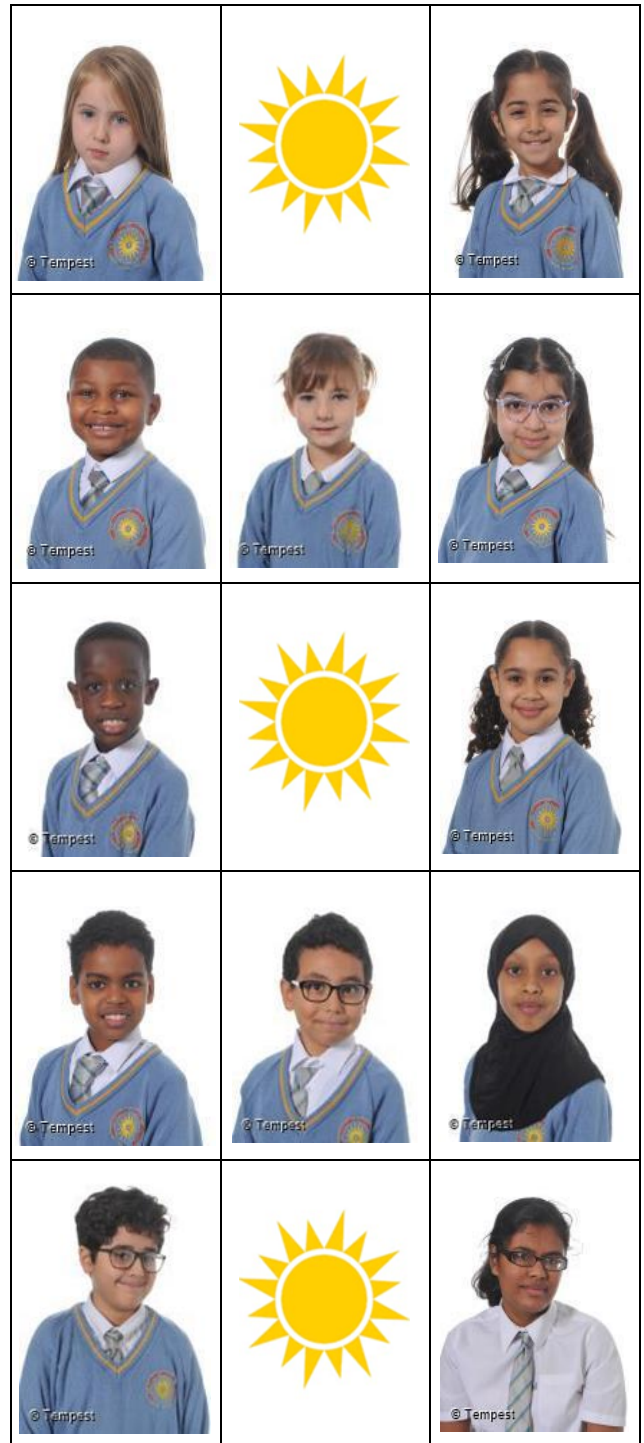
