Wishing you all a lovely bank holiday weekend too.

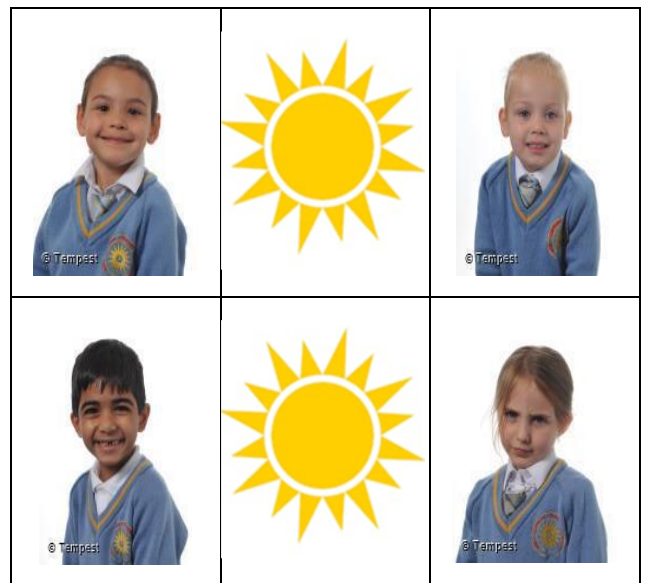
