


English

This unit in English will focus on diary entry writing. We will be looking at writing in the first person, expressing thoughts and feelings through our descriptions and retelling events. At the end of the unit, we will be writing our own diary entry from the perspective of a character in our new class book 'The Queen's Nose' and will present these to another year group in school!

Mathematics Mastery

In Maths this term we are focusing on multiplication and division. We will be learning to:

- Multiplication and division facts for 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10
- Multiplicative structures: equal groups/parts, change and comparison, correspondence problems
- Relationships: commutativity and inverse
- Multiply and divide by 10 and 100
- Multiply a 2-digit number by 2, 3, 4, 5 and corresponding division situations
- Divide 2-digit by a 1-digit



PSHE

In PSHE this term, we will be focussing on our dreams and goals. Pupils will get a chance to look at how to set goals and how to work towards them. We will be working together in groups to practice our teamwork and learn all about how this can help us to overcome challenges.

Art and Design

This term in Art, we will be looking at Still Life. We will be:

- Learning about a famous Still Life artist; Cezanne.
- Creating texture and tone in our artwork.
- Using pastels to add colour to our work.
- Creating our own Still Life artwork!

This term we are asking:
What is significant about Europe? Where in the continent would you most like to visit and why?



Science- Light and Shadow

In Year 3, pupils are taught to recognise that they need light to see things and that dark is the absence of light. They are also taught to notice that light is reflected from surfaces, to recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways we can protect our eyes from the sun. In addition, pupils are taught to recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object and to find patterns in the way that shadows change.

Home Learning

In addition to the discovery boxes received before half term, pupils will be set research to complete each week in a way of their choice.

In addition, they will receive a spelling list on Friday to be tested the following Friday and are expected to read at home every day.

Computing

This term our Computing unit is called 'Spreadsheets'. We will be learning to:

- To use the symbols more than, less than and equal to, to compare values.
- To use 2Calculate to collect data and produce a variety of graphs.
- To use the advanced mode of 2Calculate to learn about cell references.

French

In French this term, we will be learning all about Ancient Britain. We will look at the groups of people that lived during the different periods in Ancient Britain, where they lived and the different tools that they used. We will speak to each other in French to describe these different time periods.

Humanities – Stone Age to the Iron Age

This unit builds on pupils' knowledge in all strands of geography: place knowledge, locational knowledge and human and physical geography. Pupils begin the unit by using maps to focus on Europe. They identify regions, key physical and human characteristics, countries and major cities. Pupils look at Europe as a whole before diving into the regions of Northern, Southern, Eastern and Western Europe. A key theme throughout this unit is 'geographical similarities and differences'.

Sports, Health and Fitness

This half term we will:

- Fitness: Mighty Movers!
- Sport: Basket ball – Throwing and catching
- Health: Hygiene, medicine and exercise.
