

English

English this term will begin by writing a 'meeting tale narrative'. The children will learn about the key skills needed to write a 5-part narrative, including recapping how to use speech, and creating effective setting descriptions. They will be working towards writing their own meeting tale narrative, based on our new book, Percy Jackson and the Lightening Thief.

Mathematics Mastery

This term in Maths, we will begin by securing our knowledge of multiplication and division. We will be looking at the following;

- The links between multiplication and division
- Solving problems involving the 6 and 8 multiplication tables
- Multiplying 2-digit numbers by 6 and 8

After this topic, we will be moving on to exploring calculation strategies and place value.

In this unit, we will:

- Apply mental strategies for addition and subtraction
- Apply mental strategies for multiplication and division
- Explore 4-digit numbers



PSHE

This term in PSHE, our topic is Changing Me. We will learn about:

- The ways a baby changes between birth and growing up.
- How bodies change on both the inside and outside

Art and Design

This term in Art and Design, we will be making Ancient Greek pots! We will be learning about:

- What Ancient Greek pottery looks like.
- Painting images found on Greek pottery
- Designing and sculpting Greek pottery

This term we are asking:

Who were the ancient Greeks and how have they influenced our lives today?



Science- Forces

This term in science, we will be learning all about Forces and Magnets. This will include learning about the following questions:

- What are forces?
- How do objects move on different surfaces?
- What is a magnet and how do magnets react to each other?
- Which materials are magnetic?
- Are some magnets stronger than others?

Home Learning

In addition to the discovery boxes received before half term, pupils will be set research to complete each week in a way of their choice.

In addition, they will receive a spelling list on Friday to be tested the following Friday and are expected to read at home every day.

Computing

Our computing learning this term will focus on Graphing. The children will learn:

- To enter data into a graph and answer questions.
- To solve an investigation and present the results in graphic form.

French

This term in French, we will begin by completing our 'En Famillie' unit. We will then move on to our new topics, 'Au Café.' Children will be learning how to:

- Order from a selection of foods/drinks from a French menu.
- Order a French breakfast and snacks.
- Ask for the bill.

History – Ancient Greeks

This term we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks.

This will include learning about:

- How we know about the first civilisations in Ancient Greece.
- The Golden Age in Greece.
- How Athens and Sparta became important city-states.
- Alexander the Great
- The lasting achievements of the ancient Greeks

Sports, Health and Fitness

Sport: This term in sport, we will be doing Athletics! We will continue looking at different types of jumps and the skills needed in running.

Fitness: This term, we will be covering the unit, 'step to the beat', where we will be improving our stamina and strength through a mixture of aerobics and circuit training.

Health: This term, we will be learning about diet and vitamins in health. We will explore the importance of food and vitamins in keeping us healthy.
