

English

We will be writing a recipe to make our very own indulgent summer trifle inspired by the jubilee trifle. We will be moving on to writing setting descriptions of the perfect summer setting inspired by the book "Julian the Mermaid" by Jessica Love. We are challenging ourselves to accurately use adventurous verbs and adjectives to paint a picture for our reader using all our senses. We will be writing verbs in a variety of tenses while using the correct suffixes.

Mathematics Mastery

We will be developing our understanding of money. By the end of the unit, we will be able to name the coins and notes. We will demonstrate our understanding of their value by being able to represent the same value using different coins. Finally, will be applying our knowledge of difference to find change.

Our next topic will be introducing the concept of multiplication and division. Then we will move onto our final topic of capacity and volume.

Science

Our biology unit builds on our Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer unit by applying our knowledge of seasons to the life cycle of plants. We will be analysing common plants and be able to name the key parts of a plant and tree. This will lead to us answering the driving question: Why are plants so important?

Humanities

We will studying the seaside by locating some popular seaside resorts in different parts of the United Kingdom. We will look at what people do at the seaside by analysing photographs to make distinctions between different modern and historical seaside activities and going as far back as the Victorian era.

Computing

This term we will be moving onto our animated storybook unit. We will learn how to add animation, sound effects and backgrounds to a picture.

Phonics

We are continuing our daily phonics lessons and are increasing our speed and accuracy. Please keep using the Speed Sound books at home and check out the new Seesaw Phonics groups which will give you weekly links to practise at home. Finally, please enjoy reading the books that go home each Friday and ensure that they are returned each Wednesday.
