Dear Parents/Carers

The Government has announced that all schools must close from **4.00pm this Friday, March 20th, until further notice** to help stop the spread of Coronavirus.

As part of its announcement about schools, the Government also said that;

- Exams will not take place in May and June
- Schools will be open to help support the children of key workers and for vulnerable students
- Provision for food will be made for students who qualify for Free School Meals

We expect further details on how we can implement these measures in the coming days and will liaise closely with the Department for Education to ensure that we support our key worker parents and vulnerable students in the best way we can.

Our other key aim is to ensure and maintain as much stability for the students' education as possible and we have been planning for this outcome. Whilst it is not possible to fully replicate the educational experience at home, we have been working hard to put in place contingency plans to ensure students can still access work and teachers are able to support their learning.

Work will be set and shared through an initial pack of resources that will be sent home with each child. In the event of a child being absent on the closure day, we will endeavour to supply the work by hand to each household.

Please ensure that your child completes the work set for them every day. Teachers will be in contact with students at least once a week and will ask specifically if there are any difficulties with the work that has been set.

While schools are closed, we should all continue to follow health guidance.
